13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 18	(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
19 20	(2) "AIRCRAFT" MEANS A DEVICE THAT IS USED OR INTENDED TO BE USED FOR FLIGHT IN THE AIR.
21	(3) "CORRECTIONAL FACILITY" INCLUDES THE BUILDINGS AND

GROUNDS OF A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.

1	(4) "Unmanned aircraft" means an aircraft that is operated
2	WITHOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF DIRECT HUMAN INTERVENTION FROM WITHIN OR ON
3	THE AIRCRAFT.

- 4 (B) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON 5 MAY NOT OPERATE OR CAUSE THE OPERATION OF AN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT ABOVE 6 A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE SECRETARY OR 7 THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE.
- 8 (2) A PERSON MAY BE FOUND GUILTY OF VIOLATING THIS SECTION
  9 REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE PERSON KNEW OR HAD REASON TO KNOW THAT THE
  10 PERSON WAS OPERATING OR CAUSING THE OPERATION OF AN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT
  11 ABOVE A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.
- 12 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
  13 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A
  14 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR BOTH.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
