SENATE BILL 703

- 1 (h) (1) "Community detention" means a program monitored by the 2 Department of Juvenile Services in which a delinquent child [or], a child alleged to be 3 delinquent, OR A CHILD OVER WHOM A COURT EXERCISES CRIMINAL JURISDICTION 4 is placed in the home of a parent, guardian, custodian, or other fit person, or in shelter care, 5 as a condition of probation or as an alternative to detention.
- 6 (2) "Community detention" includes electronic monitoring.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 October 1, 2023.
