- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
  That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
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### Article – Human Services

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1 (2) The terms of the members are staggered as required by the terms 2 provided for the members of the Commission on October 1, 2007.

3 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 4 appointed and qualifies.

5 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the 6 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

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(5) A member may not serve more than two consecutive 3-year terms.

8 (e) A member who fails to attend at least 50% of the regularly scheduled meetings 9 of the Commission during any 12-month period shall be considered to have resigned.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2023.
