MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY, FROM 8 A.M. TO 2 A.M. THE FOLLOWING DAY.

- 1 (G) A BUSINESS FOR WHICH THE LICENSE IS ISSUED IS SUBJECT TO THE 2 ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 4-505 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 3 (H) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PURCHASE BEER AND WINE FROM A 4 RETAIL LICENSE HOLDER OR AN AUTHORIZED AND LICENSED WHOLESALER OR 5 MANUFACTURER.
- 6 (I) THE LICENSE HOLDER SHALL PROVIDE PREPACKAGED SNACKS FOR 7 PURCHASE AT ALL TIMES WHEN BEER AND WINE ARE SOLD.
- 8 (J) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$750.
- 9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 10 1, 2023.
