- IN THIS SECTION, "APPLIANCE" MEANS ANY DEVICE THAT: (A) 17
- 18 **(1)** CONTAINS AND USES A CLASS I OR CLASS II SUBSTANCE, AS DEFINED IN 42 U.S.C. 7671A, AS A REFRIGERANT; AND 19
- 20**(2)** IS USED FOR A HOUSEHOLD OR COMMERCIAL PURPOSE, 21INCLUDING AN AIR CONDITIONER, A REFRIGERATOR, A CHILLER, OR A FREEZER.



- 1 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, REGULATION, OR REQUIREMENT 2 IN THE STATE, THE USE OF A REFRIGERANT MAY NOT BE PROHIBITED OR 3 OTHERWISE LIMITED IF:
- 4 (1) THE REFRIGERANT IS DESIGNATED AS ACCEPTABLE FOR USE IN 5 ACCORDANCE WITH 42 U.S.C. 7671; AND
- 6 (2) ANY APPLIANCE CONTAINING THE REFRIGERANT DESIGNATED FOR ACCEPTABLE USE IS LABELED, INSTALLED, SERVICED, REPAIRED, USED, AND DISPOSED OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SAFETY STANDARDS AND USE CONDITIONS UNDER 42 U.S.C. 7671.
