## SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 15 (F) (1) ANY SYSTEM OPERATED BY A MANUFACTURER, DISTRIBUTOR, OR 16 FACTORY BRANCH OR ITS AFFILIATE FOR THE ALLOCATION OF NEW VEHICLES TO 17 DEALERS SHALL BE REASONABLE AND FAIR FOR ALL DEALERS.

18 (2) ON THE WRITTEN REQUEST BY ANY OF ITS DEALERS, A 19 MANUFACTURER, DISTRIBUTOR, OR FACTORY BRANCH OR ITS AFFILIATE SHALL 20 DISCLOSE TO THE DEALER THE METHOD BY WHICH NEW VEHICLES ARE ALLOCATED 21 TO DEALERS OF THE SAME LINE MAKE.
