1 (1) IF THE POLICE OFFICER IS AN EMPLOYEE OF A COUNTYWIDE OR 2 LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, TO THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE COUNTY IN 3 WHICH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IS LOCATED; AND

4 (2) IF THE POLICE OFFICER IS AN EMPLOYEE OF A STATEWIDE OR 5 BICOUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, TO THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANNE 6 ARUNDEL COUNTY.
