SENATE BILL 765

- 1 (a) This section does not apply in the 43rd legislative district.
- 2 (b) There is a Class A–7 beer, wine, and liquor license.
- 3 (c) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer, wine, and liquor at retail 4 at the place described in the license, for off–premises consumption.
- 5 (d) (1) Subject to [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) of this subsection, a 6 license holder who holds a valid Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license issued on or 7 before July 1, 2018, may apply to the Board to exchange the license for a Class A–7 license 8 if the license holder first obtains approval by resolution of the Baltimore City Council.
- 9 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A
 10 LICENSE HOLDER WHO HOLDS A VALID CLASS B-D-7 BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR
 11 LICENSE FOR PREMISES LOCATED ON THE ODD SIDE OF THE 4000 BLOCK OF
 12 FREDERICK AVENUE MAY APPLY TO THE BOARD TO EXCHANGE THE LICENSE FOR A
 13 CLASS A-7 LICENSE.
- 14 **(3)** The Board may not issue a Class A–7 license on or after July 1, 2022.
- 15 (e) A holder of a Class A–7 license may sell beer, wine, and liquor on Monday 16 through Sunday from 10 a.m. to midnight.
- 17 (f) The annual license fee is \$1,500.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2024, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
