13	restaurant operating under this Act.
14	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
15	1, 2023. It shall remain effective until 2 years after the day on which the Department of
16	Legislative Services receives notice under Section 2 of this Act, and at the end of the second

year, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated
