## Natural Resources – Female Deer Hunting Contests – Authorization

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a person,
- for the management of the deer population in the State, to sponsor, conduct, or
- 5 participate in a certain contest in the State that has the objective of harvesting a
- 6 female deer; and generally relating to doe hunting.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Article - Natural Resources

- (a) (1) Subject to [subsection (b)] PARAGRAPH (2) of this [section]
- 17 SUBSECTION, a person may not sponsor, conduct, or participate in a contest organized in
- 18 the State that has the objective of killing a coyote, fox, or raccoon for prizes or monetary
- 19 rewards.
- [(b)] (2) This [section] SUBSECTION may not be construed to prohibit:
- [(1)] (I) A landowner or the landowner's agent or lessee from killing
- 22 coyotes, foxes, or raccoons on property of the landowner, provided that the killing is not
- 23 part of an organized contest; [or]

- 4 [(c)] (3) A person is subject to a fine of \$50 for each coyote, fox, or raccoon killed 5 in violation of [subsection (a)] PARAGRAPH (1) of this [section] SUBSECTION.
- 6 (B) (1) TO MANAGE THE DEER POPULATION IN THE STATE, THE 7 DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A PERSON TO SPONSOR, CONDUCT, OR PARTICIPATE IN 8 AN EXISTING, RANDOM CONTEST IN THE STATE HELD DURING THE MONTH OF 9 JANUARY THAT HAS THE OBJECTIVE OF HARVESTING A FEMALE DEER.
- 10 (2) RANDOM LOTTERY AWARDS UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 11 SUBSECTION SHALL BE LIMITED TO THREE INDIVIDUALS PER CONTEST.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
