## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## Health Insurance - Labor and Delivery Services - Cost-Sharing Requirements

FOR the purpose of requiring certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations to provide coverage for labor and delivery services without certain cost-sharing requirements; and generally relating to cost-sharing requirements for labor and delivery services.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

> Article - Insurance

15-811.1.
(A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:
(1) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT PROVIDE LABOR AND DELIVERY COVERAGE TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES OR CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND
(2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE LABOR AND DELIVERY COVERAGE TO INDIVIDUALS OR GROUPS UNDER CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

(B) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL COVER LABOR AND 2 DELIVERY SERVICES WITHOUT A DEDUCTIBLE, COINSURANCE, COPAYMENT, OR ANY 3 OTHER COST-SHARING REQUIREMENT.
