13 - 301.Unfair, abusive, or deceptive trade practices include any: (14)Violation of a provision of: (XXXV) Section 11–210 of the Education Article; [or] (xxxvi) Title 14, Subtitle 44 of this article; or (XXXVII) SECTION 14–1327 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR 14 - 1327.(A) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS (1) INDICATED. (2) "ADVANCED DRIVER ASSISTANCE SYSTEM" ELECTRONIC SYSTEM THAT USES AUTOMATED TECHNOLOGY INCLUDING CAMERAS AND SENSORS TO DETECT NEARBY OBSTACLES AND DRIVER ERRORS TO ASSIST A DRIVER IN THE SAFE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE. (3) "MOTOR VEHICLE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN TITLE 11 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE. "MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY GLASS FACILITY" MEANS A PERSON (4) THAT: **(I) REPAIRS OR REPLACES MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY GLASS;** AND **PROVIDES RELATED RECALIBRATION OF AN ADVANCED (II)** DRIVER ASSISTANCE SYSTEM. "PERSON" INCLUDES AN INDIVIDUAL, A CORPORATION, A (5) BUSINESS TRUST, A TRUST ESTATE, AN ASSOCIATION, TWO OR MORE PERSONS HAVING A JOINT OR COMMON INTEREST, OR ANY OTHER LEGAL OR COMMERCIAL ENTITY. (6) "RECALIBRATION" MEANS THE READJUSTMENT OF CAMERAS, SENSORS, AND OTHER TECHNOLOGY IN AN ADVANCED DRIVER ASSISTANCE SYSTEM TO ENSURE PROPER WORKING ORDER IN ACCORDANCE WITH MOTOR VEHICLE

SENATE BILL 793

1 (B) BEFORE REPAIRING OR REPLACING MOTOR VEHICLE GLASS, IF A 2 MOTOR VEHICLE IS EQUIPPED WITH AN ADVANCED DRIVER ASSISTANCE SYSTEM, A 3 MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY GLASS FACILITY SHALL:

4 (1) INFORM THE CUSTOMER IF THE RECALIBRATION OF AN 5 ADVANCED DRIVER ASSISTANCE SYSTEM IS REQUIRED; AND

6 (2) PROVIDE THE CUSTOMER WITH A STATEMENT THAT THE WORK TO 7 BE PERFORMED ON THE MOTOR VEHICLE WILL MEET OR EXCEED ORIGINAL 8 EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER SPECIFICATIONS.

9 (C) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A MOTOR 10 VEHICLE SAFETY GLASS FACILITY IS NOT LIMITED TO MOTOR VEHICLE GLASS, 11 TOOLING, EQUIPMENT, OR REPAIR PROCEDURES PROVIDED BY THE VEHICLE 12 MANUFACTURER.

13(2)RECALIBRATION OF AN ADVANCED DRIVER ASSISTANCE SYSTEM14PERFORMED BY A MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY GLASS FACILITY SHALL MEET OR15EXCEED THE MOTOR VEHICLE MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS.

16(3) A MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY GLASS FACILITY MAY NOT CHARGE17FOR SERVICES THAT ARE NOT PERFORMED OR SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED.

18 **(D)** A MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY GLASS FACILITY SHALL INFORM THE 19 CUSTOMER IF RECALIBRATION OF AN ADVANCED DRIVER ASSISTANCE SYSTEM IS 20 REQUIRED AND IS NOT PERFORMED OR SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED.

21 (E) A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION BY A MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY GLASS 22 FACILITY IS:

23 (1) AN UNFAIR, ABUSIVE, OR DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE WITHIN 24 THE MEANING OF TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND

25 (2) SUBJECT TO THE ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY PROVISIONS 26 CONTAINED IN TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 October 1, 2023.
