3 **Officers and First Responders**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to provide a certain
5 discount on annual State park passes for certain first responders and law
6 enforcement officers; and generally relating to discounts on State park passes.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Natural Resources**

15 **1–407.**

16 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**
17 **INDICATED.**

1 **(2) “ANNUAL STATE PARK PASS” MEANS A PASS ISSUED BY THE**
2 **DEPARTMENT THAT ALLOWS THE HOLDER UNLIMITED DAY-USE ENTRY TO ALL**
3 **STATE PARKS AND STATE PARK FACILITIES FOR 1 YEAR.**

4 **(3) “FIRST RESPONDER” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 1-301 OF**
5 **THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.**

6 **(4) “LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §**
7 **1-101 OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.**

8 **(B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE A DISCOUNT OF AT LEAST \$40 ON**
9 **ANNUAL STATE PARK PASSES FOR ALL FIRST RESPONDERS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT**
10 **OFFICERS WHO ARE MARYLAND RESIDENTS.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2023.
