Worcester County - Natural Resources - Hunting

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a person in 4 Worcester County to hunt game birds or game mammals on a Sunday, subject to $\mathbf{5}$ certain time restrictions, during the open season for that game bird or game 6 mammal; authorizing the Department to allow a person in Worcester County to hunt 7 on public land designated for hunting on Sundays, subject to certain time restrictions; altering the safety zone in Worcester County within which archery 8 9 hunting may not take place except under certain circumstances; and generally 10 relating to hunting in Worcester County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

6 (10) The Department may allow a person shooting pen-reared game birds 7 or tower-released flighted mallard ducks to hunt on Sunday at a regulated shooting ground 8 in accordance with § 10–906 of this title.

9 (11) The Department may allow a person who is 16 years old or younger to 10 hunt on Sunday if participating in a junior hunt established by the Department in 11 accordance with this subtitle.

7 (6) In Montgomery County or Washington County, an archery hunter shall 8 be in an elevated position that allows the hunter to shoot in a downward trajectory when 9 hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling house, residence, 10 church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by human beings.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July1, 2023.
