2 Public Safety – Protecting Against Hate Crimes Grant Fund – Establishment

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Protecting Against Hate Crimes Grant Fund as a 4 special, nonlapsing fund to make grants to nonprofit organizations, including $\mathbf{5}$ faith-based organizations, to provide security enhancements to protect against hate 6 crimes; requiring the Executive Director of the Governor's Office of Crime 7 Prevention, Youth, and Victim Services to administer the Fund; requiring 8 authorizing, for fiscal year 2025 and each fiscal year thereafter, the Governor to 9 include in the annual budget bill a certain appropriation to the Fund; and generally 10 relating to the Protecting Against Hate Crimes Grant Fund.

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE PROTECTING AGAINST HATE 17 CRIMES GRANT FUND.

18 (B) THERE IS A PROTECTING AGAINST HATE CRIMES GRANT FUND.

19 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO MAKE GRANTS TO NONPROFIT 20 ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS, TO PROVIDE 21 SECURITY ENHANCEMENTS TO PROTECT AGAINST HATE CRIMES.

22 (D) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME 23 PREVENTION, YOUTH, AND VICTIM SERVICES SHALL:

 - ADMINISTER THE FUND;

25 (2) ESTABLISH AND PUBLISH PROCEDURES FOR THE DISTRIBUTION 26 OF GRANTS TO NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING FAITH-BASED 27 ORGANIZATIONS;

(3) SET ASIDE <u>A MINIMUM OF</u> \$1,000,000 EACH YEAR FOR GRANTS TO
 FAITH-BASED INSTITUTIONS <u>ORGANIZATIONS</u> TO INCREASE SECURITY MEASURES
 AGAINST FAITH-BASED HATE CRIMES, WITH PRIORITY GIVEN TO APPLICANTS THAT
 CAN DEMONSTRATE A HIGH PREVALENCE OF HATE CRIMES AGAINST MEMBERS OF
 AND INSTITUTIONS REPRESENTING THE APPLICANT'S FAITH; AND

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1 (4) SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2 2–1257 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, A REPORT ON THE DISTRIBUTION OF 3 FUNDING BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1 EACH YEAR.

4 (E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 5 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

6 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 7 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

- 8 (F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 9 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
- 10 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND

11(3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR12THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.

13 (G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO MAKE GRANTS TO NONPROFIT 14 ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS, TO PROVIDE 15 SECURITY ENHANCEMENTS TO PROTECT AGAINST HATE CRIMES.

16 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND 17 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.

18 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND, INCLUDING INTEREST 19 EARNINGS UNDER SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION, SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE 20 FUND.

21 (I) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE 22 WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

(J) MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE FUND FOR GRANTS TO NONPROFIT
 ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS, TO PROVIDE
 SECURITY ENHANCEMENTS TO PROTECT AGAINST HATE CRIMES IS SUPPLEMENTAL
 TO AND IS NOT INTENDED TO TAKE THE PLACE OF FUNDING THAT OTHERWISE
 WOULD BE APPROPRIATED FOR PROVIDING NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS,
 INCLUDING FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS, WITH SECURITY ENHANCEMENTS TO
 PROTECT AGAINST HATE CRIMES.

30 (K) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE 31 GOVERNOR <u>SHALL MAY</u> INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION 32 OF \$5,000,000 TO THE FUND.
