## 2 Public Safety - Protecting Against Hate Crimes Grant Fund - Establishment

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Protecting Against Hate Crimes Grant Fund as a 4 special, nonlapsing fund to make grants to nonprofit organizations, including 5 faith-based organizations, to provide security enhancements to protect against hate 6 crimes; requiring the Executive Director of the Governor's Office of Crime 7 Prevention, Youth, and Victim Services to administer the Fund; requiring, for fiscal 8 year 2025 and each fiscal year thereafter, the Governor to include in the annual 9 budget bill a certain appropriation to the Fund; and generally relating to the 10 Protecting Against Hate Crimes Grant Fund.

- 5 (1) MONEY APPROPRIATED IN THE STATE BUDGET TO THE FUND;
- 6 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND; AND
- 7 (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR
- 8 THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 9 (G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO MAKE GRANTS TO NONPROFIT
- 10 ORGANIZATIONS, INCLUDING FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS, TO PROVIDE

- 12 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND
