16 17 18 19	(a) Subject to the provisions of subsection (b) of this section, a [free association] PUBLIC , school, college, or university library in this State shall prohibit inspection, use, or disclosure of any circulation record or other item, collection, or grouping of information about an individual that:

21 22	(2) Contains an individual's name or the identifying number, symbol, or other identifying particular assigned to the individual; and
