Election Law - Automatic Voter Registration - Alterations

3 FOR the purpose of altering automatic voter registration procedures at the Motor Vehicle 4 Administration and the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange; requiring the voter 5 registration information of certain applicants at the Administration and the 6 Exchange to be transmitted to the State Board of Elections under certain 7 circumstances; requiring the State Board to process the voter registration 8 information of certain applicants at the Administration and the Exchange who are 9 currently registered to vote in a certain manner and send a certain notice to each applicant; requiring the State Board to process the voter registration information of 10 11 certain applicants at the Administration and the Exchange who are not currently 12 registered to vote in a certain manner and send a certain notice to each applicant; 13 authorizing the State Board to implement certain automatic voter registration procedures at certain agencies with the consent of the agencies; providing that 14 15 certain automatic voter registration procedures do not apply to participants in 16 certain confidentiality programs; and generally relating to automatic voter 17 registration.
