10 11 12	(E) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025, AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION OF \$5,000,000 TO THE OFFICE TO AWARD GRANTS FOR THE PROGRAM.
