## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 **Natural Resources – Fishing Licenses and Stamps – Exemptions**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to issue an annual  
4 fishing license and stamp exemption to certain entities and organizations to provide  
5 fishing clinics and instructional opportunities to certain individuals; altering certain  
6 reporting requirements for certain entities and organizations that are issued certain  
7 fishing license and stamp exemptions; and generally relating to exemptions to  
8 requirements to obtain a fishing license or stamp.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 16 **Article – Natural Resources**

17 4-217.

18 (a) (1) The Department may issue a 1-day license exemption to a nonprofit  
19 organization to take individuals with physical or mental disabilities fishing from shore in  
20 the tidal or nontidal waters of the State.

21 (2) The primary caregiver or representative of the organization attending  
22 to the disabled individuals is included in the license exemption under this subsection.

23 (3) Application for a license exemption for an organization attending to  
24 disabled individuals shall state the location, time, and day of the event and the number of

1 individuals covered by the exemption.

2 (b) (1) The Department may issue an annual license exemption to a  
3 governmental entity or a nonprofit organization to [take]:

4 (I) TAKE individuals with physical or mental disabilities who are  
5 serving or have served in the armed forces of the United States fishing in the tidal or  
6 nontidal waters of the State; OR

7 (II) PROVIDE FISHING CLINICS AND INSTRUCTIONAL  
8 OPPORTUNITIES TO:

9 1. INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE SERVING OR HAVE SERVED IN  
10 THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES;

11 2. INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE PARTICIPATING IN A  
12 PHYSICAL OR MENTAL WELLNESS OUTDOOR EVENT;

13 3. INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE PARTICIPATING IN A SPECIAL  
14 NEEDS OUTDOOR EVENT;

15 4. INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ACTING UNDER THE  
16 AUTHORITY OF A SCIENTIFIC COLLECTION PERMIT ISSUED UNDER § 4-212 OF THIS  
17 SUBTITLE; OR

18 5. RESIDENTS OF THE STATE WHO ARE UNDERSERVED  
19 WITH RESPECT TO FISHING OPPORTUNITIES, AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT  
20 IN REGULATION.

21 (2) The primary caregiver or representative of the governmental entity or  
22 a nonprofit organization attending to [a disabled] OR INSTRUCTING AN individual under  
23 this subsection is included in the license exemption.

24 (3) An application for a license exemption for a governmental entity or a  
25 nonprofit organization attending to [a disabled] OR INSTRUCTING AN individual under  
26 this subsection shall be made on a form provided by the Department.

27 (4) A governmental entity or a nonprofit organization with an exemption  
28 under this subsection shall submit a report to the Department by January 1 of the year  
29 following the exemption period that [states]:

30 (i) The locations fished under the exemption;

31 (ii) The dates the exemption was used; and

(iii) The number of individuals who were covered by the exemption]

2 PROVIDES CERTAIN EVENT AND PARTICIPANT INFORMATION AS REQUIRED BY THE  
3 DEPARTMENT.

4 (c) The primary caregiver or representative of the governmental entity or  
5 nonprofit organization exempted under subsection (a) or (b) of this section shall have in  
6 possession the letter of exemption from the Director of the Fisheries Service while the  
7 organization is engaged in fishing activity.

(2) Engage in angling for trout on the nontidal waters of the State without holding a trout stamp under § 4-614 of this title; and

17 (e) An angler's license is not required of the following:

24 (i) The administrator of the mental health care facility, or treating  
25 physician or psychologist provides the Department with a letter stating that the caregiver  
26 or family member is the primary caretaker of the patient; or

27 (ii) The individual accompanying the patient carries a copy of the  
28 letter described under item (i) of this item, or a professional license or certificate of a health  
29 care professional involved in the care of the patient.

30 (F) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS  
31 SECTION.

32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June  
33 1, 2023.
