1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Construction Education and Innovation Fund – Funding – Alteration**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the amount of a certain appropriation the Governor is required
4 to include in the annual budget bill for the Maryland Construction Education and
5 Innovation Fund for certain fiscal years; and generally relating to funding for the
6 Maryland Construction Education and Innovation Fund.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Labor and Employment**

2 (a) There is a Construction Education and Innovation Fund.

3 (d) The Fund consists of:

4 (1) money appropriated in the State budget to the Fund;

5 (2) money made available to the Fund through federal programs or private
6 contributions;

7 (3) money derived by the Center; or

8 (4) any other money made available to the Center for the Fund.

9 (e) (1) For fiscal year 2018 [and each fiscal year thereafter] THROUGH
10 FISCAL YEAR 2024, the Governor shall include in the annual [State] budget BILL an
11 appropriation to the Fund of \$250,000 to support the operation of the Center.

12 (2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 ~~AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER~~
13 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2029, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL
14 BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION TO THE FUND OF \$625,000 TO SUPPORT THE
15 OPERATION OF THE CENTER.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
17 1, 2023.
