10. Description and Purpose of Organiza	tion (Limit lengt	h to visible area)			

The purpose of Alim Academy (AA) is to produce well-educated, moral, confident and innovative global citizens. AA is a non-profit k-12 school that was founded in 1981. With more than 120 students, its admission is open to students regardless of their ethnicity or religious affiliations. AA has graduated hundreds of students and served a significant number of Montgomery county residents and the greater DMV area. Schools building is open to public and used during the weekends for different kids language educations and art activities. The playground is currently estimated to be used by 15,000 children (annually) with no restriction. This renovation project is expected to increase the number of users to 28,000 annually and greatly improve the safety of the children.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The purpose of the project is to: 1) repair and renovate the deteriorated playground blacktop (8,532 sqft), which has become uneven with an improper water drainage. This area is used daily by hundreds of kids and due to its poor status, it has become a challenge to use it properly. The funding will be used to remove the old asphalt and level the base of the current blacktop; then new asphalt will be placed, followed by its marking for the volleyball/basketball courts. 2) Add equipment in turfed playground to serve kids in different age groups of less than 5 and between 5-12 years old. The turfed area is typically used by several tens of kids daily. School recently installed 8800 sqft artificial turf in the kids playground to replace the mulch. Part of the requested funding in this proposal will be used for installing new equipment. This renovation will also catalyze hiring two instructors for the early childhood and two teachers in the k-12 program.
