Design and construct improvements along City transportation corridors to improve pedestrian safety, slow driver speeds, and provide for multi-modal transportation including bicycles and pedestrians. - Villa Estates (Area bound by 7th, Military, Rosemont, US15) : Striping to add parking lanes and crosswalks in addition to signage - N Bentz St Restriping Project (W 7th St to Dill Ave) : Striping to shift parking to alternate side between blocks and add crosswalks - Himes Ave Directional Protected Bike Lane Project (MD 180 to Butterfly Lane) : Repurpose existing outside lanes to a 6 wide bike lane with a 4 buffer to encourage reductions in speed and improve accessibility - McClellan Dr Striping Project (Opossumtown Pk to Christophers Crossing) : Add centerline, crosswalks, and new signage - Willowdale Dr (Shookstown Road to US Alt.40) Buffered bike lanes, traffic circle, all way stop control, crosswalks and signage
