The City of Gaithersburg is a municipal governmental organization responsible for the administration of the City of Gaithersburg, Maryland's third largest city with a population of approximately 70,000 people.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The City acquired this public park site from the developers of the Crown Community. This project will support its development as a park and rehabilitate several historic farm buildings located on the site. The City took ownership of the park parcel in January of 2020. The project will be completed in phases, including the renovation of the Corn Crib Barn. The park design will start in FY24 and finish in FY24. Park construction will begin in FY24 and finish in FY26. As part of the architecture/engineering design process, the City will also repair the grain silos on the site that sustained weather damage in FY24.
