10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

Easterseals DC MD VA is leading the way to full equity, inclusion and access. Since 1945, we have worked to enhance quality of life and expand access to healthcare, education and employment. A local 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, we take a holistic approach, providing comprehensive services to thousands of people, no matter their disability, military status, income, race or age. To help children reach their full potential, we provide personalized child development and early intervention services. To improve health and reduce isolation in adults with disabilities, we offer engaging activities, expansive resources, and employment support. To enable military families to integrate into the community, we provide a suite of services, including employment support and mental healthcare. And to sustain families and caregivers, we provide comprehensive services and supports.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Developed as a public-private partnership among Montgomery County, the State of Maryland and Easterseals, the Easterseals Inter-Generational Center addresses some of the most critical challenges faced by our community. It is also internationally recognized for its innovative delivery model and the excellence in its outcomes. The subject project will involve 1) replacement of three aging HVAC units; 2) replacement of the roof including membrane, shingles, and fireproofing; 3) the update of restrooms on three floors consisting of 14 standard stalls and six ADA-compliant stalls.; and 4) new furniture to better meet client needs in our Adult Medical Day Services program. These capital upgrades will ensure that all programming based in our IGC can continue without any type of interruption for years to come.
