The Blueprint for Maryland's Future aims to significantly expand pre-k programs which will bring even more students to our building and return students from regional programs back to their home school. It is a priority that the EES playground is an inclusive playground for our community. Our design includes researched based elements from Universal Design theory for inclusive playgrounds. Elements include ramps, multiple levels, several slides, climbing structures, spinning structures and sensory panels.
