10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

Forest Heights is a growing town located in the state of Maryland. With a population of 2,517 people and just one neighborhood though bisected by Indian Head Highway / MD Route 210 (a continuance of South Capitol Avenue from within the District of Columbia) - Forest Heights is the 180th largest community in Maryland. Forest Heights is a stone's throw from the Washington, DC line on its northern border, and aligned at its southern border with the

the Washington, DC line on its northern border, and aligned at its southern border with the Capital Beltway (Interstate 495). Unlike some towns where white-collar or blue-collar occupations dominate the local economy, Forest Heights is neither predominantly one nor the other. Instead, it has a mixed workforce of both white- and blue-collar jobs. Overall, Forest Heights is a town of sales and office workers, service providers and professionals.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The Forest Heights Public Safety Center will become the headquarters to the Forest Heights Police Department. The Police Department was once housed in Town Hall which it quickly outgrew due to expansion of the Town and its law enforcement force. The department was then located in a temporary structure on a piece of Town land which they also outgrew at a rapid rate. The department is now houses in a leased office building space within the Town. The purpose of this project is to create a permanent home for the department of public safety which would include the police department, emergency management, and certain other Town services. It would also provide a more accessible location to the community members who needed to access public safety services and resources.
