Preservation Maryland, Towson University and Baltimore County are partnering to adaptively reuse the historic 1870s Pest House (short for 'pestilence'). The project will include significant stabilization work and restoration of the structures exterior to preserve the historic, aesthetic, and cultural character of the property. The interior of the building will be renovated to facilitate use as a laboratory and education space for community archaeology in the Baltimore area. This adapted structure will house the Baltimore Community Archaeology Lab (BCAL), enabling community activities directed by a Towson University faculty member and funded through external grants and contracts.
