Hope House Treatment Centers is one of the largest community based inpatient addiction treatment centers in Maryland established in 1977, serving 75% of patients having Medicaid, as well as patients with private pay, or no insurance . Our Crownsville location serves 49 beds that provide medically monitored detoxification, inpatient residential, PHP, IOP, and OP services. Additionally, we provide Family groups for no cost to the attendees. It is our mission to provide quality, holistically integrated patient centered treatment for substance use, disorders, and related co-occurring mental health challenges, in a setting that is strengthened by unconditional kindness, and offer patients the tools necessary for recovery.

Project 1: Elevator Replacement Our Elevator is over 40 years old, and has required major repairs throughout the years, and has cost the organization thousands of dollars in repairs. The Elevator breaks down frequently jeopardizing our ability to remain Wheelchair accessible for our patients and staff as required by state regulations. The cost for this project before inflation is: \$218,775.00. Project 2: Water Well We will require us to have our own water well system within the near future. This will require drilling to be performed on the property, and the installation of a water well. The cost for this project before inflation is: \$64,900. Project 3: Cafeteria and Kitchen Renovation Both Kitchen and Cafeteria are both over 40 years old, although there have been some minor improvements, both require major renovations for flooring, walls, drains, and air conditioning repair, The cost of this project before inflation is:\$57,900
