10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

The purpose of IEC is to promote Islamic values via educating people, and supporting a culture of tolerance and dialog. Over the years, irrespective of religious orientation or ethnicity, IEC has served public and supported the broader community of Montgomery county (MC) by providing a health clinic and also by providing free freshly made food in its kitchen. IEC (est. in 1981) is a non-profit and known community center in the MC that annually receives at least 85,000 visitors. During the 2 years of covid, where most families had to stay home, IEC served more than 50,000 meals to public in its parking lot (packaged, every Thursday of the month). Families with hardship benefited from this service. IEC kitchen equipment has become very old, limiting assisting the needy families of the MC. Through this funding, it would be possible to renovate the kitchen equipment.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The purpose of the project is to renovate IEC kitchen equipment (about 800 sqft), i.e., purchase and installation of new equipment. Annually, IEC kitchen provides about 40,000 free meals to the community and public. The current kitchen equipment dates back to early 1980s with either small capacity or deteriorated function, prohibiting the ability to scale up the # of meals. The proposed renovation includes purchase of three Heavy Duty Food Warmers, one 60 Gas Broiler, one Heavy Duty Range Stock Pot, one Walk in Combination Cooler & Freezer and one Beef Skewer Machine. By replacing the old units, it is expected to save a great amount on gas consumption, and significantly increase the number of packaged meals and food variety to about 66,000 meals, depending on the availability of raw materials. We expect this renovation to build stronger ties with the MC meal programs for a more effective outreach to in-need families.
