10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

KidzStuff Child Care Centers serve children birth through 12 years of age through full day programming, before/after school programming with transportation, and summer programming. Our mission is to provide the best foundation for children birth to five through a Christian education with a focus on closing the school readiness gap in the Baltimore Metropolitan Area. We believe each child is uniquely special. It is our goal to provide children with a safe nurturing environment that provides activities for language and communication, creative arts, social, emotional, cognitive, and physical development to enhance and support the development of the whole child. It is our vision to produce resilient young learners who have faith, are fearless, and can lead. We want every student graduating from our program to believe they can do anything as they grow up.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The newly renovated KidzStuff Child Care Center for Children with Disabilities will be the only all day early childhood education facility in Baltimore City to serve children with disabilities, between the ages of 2 and five years. The program will provide academic learning and various forms of therapeutic services. There will be inclusion opportunities for our new students with atypical students on the campus directly across the street. We will provide parenting support services, teaching parents how to care for and support their child(ren) through the early learning developmental stages. An outdoor space designed to allow children with disabilities to freely play will be erected in the back of the building. An ADA designed parking lot will be placed on the side of the building to accommodate vehicles transporting children to and from the program. This program will provide 10-20 Employment Opportunities in the community.
