The SoccerPlex provides opportunities in multiple sports for both youth players and adults.							

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Comfort Station Renovations The existing comfort stations located throughout the complex near the outdoor fields need renovations due to heavy use over the last 20 years. These comfort stations all require new flooring, fixtures, lighting, paint, and ventilation. There are four comfort stations located at the SoccerPlex and all require updating. There are several areas at the SoccerPlex that do not have water and sewer lines run to allow for a full comfort station to be installed. These areas are currently services by portable restroom units. These units are expensive and are less than ideal in terms of cleanliness and hygiene. A vaulted comfort station is brick and wood structure that have normal bathroom style fixtures; however, all waste is stored in a sealed vault underground that is pumped out like a septic system. These comfort stations provide long term savings, improved customer experience, and better environmental protections.

(Additional Description of Project Scope and Purpose)

Renovations of Fieldhouse Restrooms/Locker Rooms

As with most areas of the Fieldhouse, major renovations have not occurred in the restrooms and locker rooms since the original construction of the facility. The current mens and womens restrooms need new flooring, fixtures, paint, and lighting. The family restrooms need new flooring, fixtures, paint, lighting, and changing stations. The home and away locker rooms have received some updates over the years during the Washington Spirits tenure at the SoccerPlex, so they need less work. Both locker rooms could use new flooring and new bathroom fixtures. The away locker room currently does not have full lockers, only a shelf and clothing rack. Ideally, we would install the same lockers that are currently in the home locker room.

Construction of Officials Locker Room(s)

The Maryland SoccerPlex and Adventist HealthCare Fieldhouse does not currently have officials locker rooms. As we increase the usage by professional sports teams and events, our needs for officials locker rooms grows. Our current solution is to close off the family restrooms to use as official locker rooms on game days. This present two issues, first the lack of family restrooms, and secondly, the inability to accommodate mixed gender officiating crews.

The lack of these accommodations prevents us from bidding on certain events and games to be hosted at the SoccerPlex. The current setup also is less than ideal for both the officials and the general public due to the restroom restrictions.

This project would extend the building to our north pad location with two officials locker room spaces and a small officials meeting room. This would require the construction of a new building or extension of the existing building plus electric, plumbing, and HVAC run to the new location.
