10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)				
The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) is a bi-county agency empowered by the State of Maryland in 1927 to acquire, develop, maintain, and administer a regional system of parks in Prince George's and Montgomery Counties. Additionally, M-NCPPC is responsible for preparing and administering a General Plan for the physical development of most of the bi-county area and operating the public recreation program in Prince George's County.				

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

The adopted Formula 2040: The Master Plan for Parks, Recreation, and Open Space divides the county into nine Service Areas. From the center of each service area, recreational facility access should be within a 15-minute travel time. It was recommended that 13,000 sq ft of additional non-aquatic recreation space be constructed in the North College Park area. The Department has completed a feasibility study to determine the location, program, conceptual design, and cost for that facility. The new facility will include a gymnasium, multi-purpose rooms, fitness areas, teen room, administrative spaces, and outdoor amenities.
