10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					
As a former North High science teacher and the individual who is applying for funding, my purpose is simple, I want to make positive change in my community. If renovated, the track has infinite potential educationally, socially, and economically. My involvement in the community allows me to understand the importance of providing safe spaces for students and members of the community to exercise. After much thought and consideration, I approached the local school board to inquire about the track and how to have it reconditioned. The next					

step in the process was to apply for a Private Public Partnership through WCPS. Please note

that I am in the final stages of obtaining approval.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The purpose of the project is to renovate the old 400m running track at North Hagerstown High School. Over the years, the track has deteriorated and is not usable. Renovations will include removal of deteriorated track materials, replacing subgrade, subbase and base where needed, and capping the surface with non-rubberized asphalt. The last phase of the project will include lane striping. The proposed construction schedule will be contingent on funding and permits. The benefits of the project include but are not limited to 1) providing North Highs physical education outdoor classes, 2) introducing urban-based physical education classes such as learn-to-skate programs rather than the traditional ball sports, and 3) providing a community track that is a safe space to exercise. The track would have a positive economic impact on the local community as it has the potential to host events beyond normal school programs.
