The Salisbury School is a small independent school and the primary host site for Horizons Delmarva, the tremendously successful program to boost the academic performance of students from low-income households. The Salisbury School has served as the campus for Horizons elementary-aged children in Wicomico County for nearly 20 years. The Salisbury School has continually partnered with Horizons in its mission to close the income-driven academic achievement gap through the generous donation of its campus and facilities for both the Horizons six-week Summer Learning Program and year-round student engagement activities.					

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The amphitheater will serve The Salisbury School and Horizons students as a gathering place for performances, assemblies, classes, speakers, and other enrichment. The Salisbury School does not have a theater or auditorium; the gym is currently used, which requires coordination with other activities. This outdoor facility will be a permanent, reasonably priced improvement. Horizons Executive Director Joe Laque states: "This amphitheater would be an important part of our Horizons Delmarva facilities. We would use the amphitheater every day for our STEM-based lessons during the Horizons Summer Learning Program. It would also serve as a perfect forum for both assemblies of the students as well as parents during our parent workshops on such subjects as financial literacy, health and nutrition, and recognizing bullying and depression. Please support this important proposal, which will be a huge benefit to our program and the students that we serve."
