This project includes the improvement and replacement of stage, house, and emergency lighting systems in the Owings Mills High School auditorium and the replacement of the scoring system in the gymnasium. This work includes, but is not limited to, replacement of lighting fixtures, control panels, power wiring, and control wiring in the auditorium, and replacement of the gym scoreboard and controller and associated power and data wiring.
