Cross Community, Inc. (CCI) exists to advance unity, equity and racial reconciliation in Montgomery County, Maryland through education, advocacy, meeting food insecurity needs, practicing hospitality, and by helping the faith community to be more effective in this work. CCI mobilizes mutual care and service to build community, empower hope, and change lives especially for vulnerable and low-income residents in Montgomery Village/Gaithersburg and surrounding areas. CCI exists to offer effective solutions to post-pandemic recovery needs through innovative ideas, nimble infrastructures and collaborative approaches. CCI has become a trusted and critical partner in community empowerment and development work in Montgomery County.						

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

This is a collaborative partnership project that will help meet critical community needs by starting and operating a new 4-classroom, Quality Childcare and Early Development Center strategically co-located with a Non-Profit Hub for greater service and impact. The Hub will meet childcare and child development, food and resource insecurity, workforce and economic development, and personal empowerment needs for local residents. The Hub will operate in a 7,000+ sq. ft. (with outdoor play) space strategically located in Gaithersburg. The Hub will create at least 60 new seats for 3 and 4 year-olds and serve a total of 180 children from primarily low-income households. It will also include an Adult Learning and Family Support Center, regular Food and Resource Distributions, and a Workforce Development Center. This is the only childcare expansion project in upper Montgomery County ready to begin and start operations. With funding, this project will begin operations in 2024.
