Our goal is to improve risk management and access to the exhibits by; Installation of handrail for outside steps leading to Offord Park to provide support for visitors to traverse from the parking lot to the picnic area, Upgrade septic system for all visitors. As visitation increases we have found that our current system is stretched; Update access ramp for visitors using walkers, wheel chairs or with mobility challenges to access the second floor of the museum. Installation of one passenger elevator to increase access for individuals with mobility challenges to access the second floor exhibits. Acquire a AED (defibrillator) as the museum does not currently have one in the premise. This will allow us to respond efficiently to potential health crises.
