10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					
The City of Fredericks Department of Housing and Human Services (DHHS) aims to ameliorate the causes and effects of poverty by offering an array of services to Frederick residents. Located in downtown Frederick, DHHS empowers community members in need to access available programs within each of the following divisions: Food and Nutrition, Health Care, Homeless Services, and Housing and Weatherization. Through these broad divisions, and with the coordinating efforts of case management services, it is the goal of DHHS to assist community members in addressing immediate emergent concerns and developing skills to engineer future success for the individual or family.					

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

In 2022, DHHS began the rebranding process of what was formerly known as the Soup Kitchen. Now named Community Table, this 3000 sq. ft. space requires capital improvements to advance the DHHS mission and to extend a helping hand to the most vulnerable members of our community. The Community Table, which serves a nutritiously balanced hot meal to 80+ individuals daily, is located in a former train depot in downtown Frederick. This space has not been renovated since the 1980s and currently presents as rather dreary. It is the vision of DHHS to transform the Community Table into a warm and welcoming environment. This will be achieved by creating an inclusive atmosphere that creates a sense of community, respect, and dignity. Beyond providing nutritious food, this space offers opportunities to coordinate other services to address underlying causes of poverty and hunger and to offer additional services to those we assist.
