10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)		
<p>Saint John the Evangelist School is a Roman Catholic, Pre-School through Grade 8, parish school serving 552 students. SJES focus is a 21st Century education rooted in a tradition of academic excellence and Catholic Faith. In a community of faith and building relationships with the Gospel values of Jesus Christ, our faculty and staff work together to fully develop each child to the best of his and her ability; spiritually, academically, artistically, socially, and physically. Faculty and staff do so in a nurturing environment that promotes living faith, academic excellence, leadership, and service within the school, the Church community, and the broader society. Saint John School is a Green School and was awarded the National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence.</p>		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

School security is integral to school culture and a funding priority for many campuses nationwide. Saint John the Evangelist, with its proximity to Ritchie Highway, will improve safety and security for all students and faculty on campus with this building project. The school entrance project would add a vestibule for security outside the existing main doors. A second layer of entrance will allow staff to screen visitors before they enter the main portion of the building and provide an additional barrier to anyone trying to gain entry without permission. The project will include some renovation to the existing lobby area, as well as updated furnishings, to support visibility and flow for those entering and exiting the main doors of the school.
