The school entrance project would add a vestibule for security outside the existing main doors. A second layer of entrance will allow staff to screen visitors before they enter the main portion of the building and provide an additional barrier to anyone trying to gain entry without permission. The project will include some renovation to the existing lobby area, as well as updated furnishings, to support visibility and flow for those entering and exiting the main doors of the school.
