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Tiferes Golda is a non-profit organization that is dedicated to supporting girls with learning disabilities. The program services girls on an elementary level and aims to have them mainstreamed into a general program for middle school, with the necessary supports in place. The students are given all the necessary therapies as well as collaboration between therapists and teachers to ensure the girls have continued and consistent support in all areas. From a social aspect, since the girls have similar profiles, they are able to relate to each other and form true friendships which is crucial for their emotional and social wellbeing- and their

educational success.

The project would allow Tiferes Golda to obtain classroom space for both the current class that it supports and a second class, along with space for the therapy/administrative services. Currently, the program has been awarded its current classroom facility free of charge, however, they are unable to continue to provide the classroom free of charge and there is definitely no possibility of completing the necessary expansion to accommodate the growth of the program. The program's growth is fueled by a wide range of applicants that are coming from across the community within which it is located and is necessary to provide the students with the facilities and program to overcome their learning challenges in an inclusive environment.
