From our founding in 1865, Zion Evangelical Lutheran United Church of Christ has a long, proud history of serving the community of greater Baltimore. We have over the years hosted: Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, NA, AA, Senior Citizen groups, a theater group, Streets of Hope homeless shelter, and many other groups. Obviously as a Christian church, we are committed to the teachings of Jesus Christ. The Cabin project, however, is non-sectarian. We want to restore the Cabin so that it can be used again by Scouts, Veterans, and any youth or community group. The Cabin is a local landmark and can provide today's youth with an opportunity to step away from electronics and cultivate an interest in nature. The location of the Cabin nestled in the woods yet close to suburbia provides a geographically convenient location for camping and meetings.

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

The purpose of the project is restoration of this 600 sq ft Cabin for youth and others to meet and learn. The structural components of the Cabin are intact; it has unfortunately fallen on a short period of neglect. The following repairs are needed: replace broken logs in rear wall, line chimney/point up masonry so fireplace can be used again as a heat source, upgrade electrical system, remove broken furnace and oil storage tank, install gutters/rainspouts, and upgrade security system. People to be served: Scouts: Merit Badge Days of 200+ Scouts, Camping weekends of 25+ Scouts/adults, Troop weekly meetings; Veterans: 200 attending Flag Retirement Ceremonies; Zion Members: Events, Zion has 175 members; Cemetery Visitors: Unknown number of people visit our cemetery of 2250 graves; Golden Ring Co-op Residents: Folks from 154 units can walk to Cabin area; Community and School groups: Advertise use of repaired Cabin, can envision 800+ visitors.
