# AN ACT concerning

# County Local Procurements - Minority Business Enterprise Utilization Programs - Certification

FOR the purpose of requiring that a county <u>or municipality</u> that operates a minority business enterprise utilization program and has a process for the certification of minority business enterprises shall accept as certified a person that holds a certification as a minority business enterprise by the State certification agency; and generally relating to <del>county</del> <u>local</u> procurements.

Article – Local Government Section <del>12–304</del> <u>1–404</u> Annotated Code of Maryland (2013 Volume and 2022 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article - Local Government

### <del>12-304.</del> 1-404.

- (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO ALL COUNTIES AND MUNICIPALITIES.
- (B) A COUNTY <u>OR MUNICIPALITY</u> THAT OPERATES A MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE UTILIZATION PROGRAM FOR COUNTY <u>OR MUNICIPAL</u> PROCUREMENTS AND HAS A PROCESS FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES FOR ELIGIBILITY IN THAT PROGRAM SHALL ACCEPT AS CERTIFIED FOR THE <del>COUNTY</del> PROGRAM ANY PERSON THAT HAS BEEN CERTIFIED AS A MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE BY THE STATE CERTIFICATION AGENCY DESIGNATED UNDER § 14–303(B) OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
