SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Business Occupations and Professions

8-201.

There is a State Board of Certified Interior Designers in the Department.

8-602.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2024] **2034**.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2023.
