Chapter 300

(Senate Bill 567)

AN ACT concerning

Public Institutions of Higher Education – Student Withdrawal Policy – Reimbursement of Tuition and Fees (Cameron Carden Act of 2024)

FOR the purpose of requiring each public institution of higher education to adopt a policy to authorize a student to withdraw under extenuating circumstances and reimburse <u>refund</u> the student for tuition and fees paid <u>by the student</u> for a certain semester under certain circumstances; and generally relating to withdrawal policies at public institutions of higher education.

BY adding to

Article – Education Section 15–138 Annotated Code of Maryland (2022 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

15 - 138.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES" INCLUDES:
 - (1) ILLNESS;
 - (2) INJURY;
 - (3) HOSPITALIZATION; AND
 - (4) MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS.

(B) (1) EACH PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ADOPT A POLICY THAT AUTHORIZES A STUDENT TO WITHDRAW FOR EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

(2) THE POLICY UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE A PROVISION TO REIMBURSE <u>REFUND</u> A STUDENT FOR TUITION AND FEES PAID <u>BY THE STUDENT</u> FOR THE SEMESTER IN WHICH THE STUDENT WITHDRAWS IF

THE EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES INHIBIT THE STUDENT'S ABILITY TO ACQUIRE AN EDUCATION AT THE PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, AS DEFINED IN POLICY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
