(House Bill 766)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County – Roadside Solicitation of Money or Donations – Prohibition

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle in Calvert County; and generally relating to roadside solicitation of money or donations in Calvert County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

21–507.

(c) In **CALVERT COUNTY**, Carroll County, Charles County, Harford County, and Washington County, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
