(House Bill 1472)

AN ACT concerning

**Professional and Volunteer Firefighter Innovative Cancer Screening
Technologies Program – Funding**

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Governor, beginning in a certain fiscal year, to include a certain amount in the annual budget for the Professional and Volunteer Firefighter Innovative Cancer Screening Technologies Program; and generally relating to the Professional and Volunteer Firefighter Innovative Cancer Screening Technologies Program.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Health – General

13–4001.

In this subtitle, “Program” means the Professional and Volunteer Firefighter Innovative Cancer Screening Technologies Program.

13–4006.

(a) **(1)** For fiscal [year 2021 and each fiscal year thereafter] **YEARS 2021 THROUGH 2024**, the Governor shall include at least \$100,000 in the annual budget for the Program.

(2) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR MAY INCLUDE AT LEAST \$500,000 IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE PROGRAM.

(b) Appropriations and expenditures made for the purpose of implementing the Program, including the use of any funds received by a person under any component of the Program, are subject to audit by the Office of Legislative Audits as provided in § 2-1220 of the State Government Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
