"BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

in line 18, strike "13–418 and 16–402(a)(17)" and substitute "21–1112.2"; and strike in their entirety lines 21 through 25, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "That" in line 2 down through the comma in line 4; strike in their entirety lines 7 through 22, inclusive; in lines 24, 25, 26, and 27, in each instance, strike the bracket; in line 25, strike "IN A MANNER THAT MAY PREVENT IDENTIFICATION"; strike beginning with "A" in line 27 down through "BE:" in line 28; and after line 28, insert:

"21–1112.2.
