in line 14, strike "2–203(a)(1) and"; and strike in their entirety lines 17 through 21, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 8, insert:

- "(f) The Office of People's Counsel may retain as necessary for a particular matter or hire experts in the field of:
- (1) <u>utility regulation, including cost of capital experts, rate design</u> experts, accountants, economists, engineers, transportation specialists, and <u>lawyers; [and]</u>

(2) <u>climate change, including meteorologists, oceanographers, ecologists, foresters, geologists, seismologists, botanists, and experts in any other field of science that the People's Counsel determines is necessary; AND</u>

On page 4, in lines 26 and 27, strike "AND THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S COUNSEL".
